

Evaluation of Sports Premium 2017 – 2018

PE is still rewarded during good work assemblies, and this has raised the profile of PE across the whole school. Class stars are being given out during the assemblies for classes that have all of their PE kits, and have a positive attitude towards PE during lessons. The profile of PE has risen with children wanting to represent the school at competitions and participate in extracurricular activities.

1. 20+ medals at Saffron Lane with the maximum amount of children qualifying for QuadKids.
2. Best results at QuadKids Yr 3 /4 ranked 2nd in Leicester Yr 5/ 6 4th in Leicester
3. Maintained 2nd place in East Leicester indoor sports hall athletics.
4. 2nd in East/west Leicester in Basketball. 2nd in the County 4th the year before
5. 1st or 2nd in all the intra-trust Goals competitions

SEN provision has increase with the sports premium, allowing the school to make a donation to Leicester Tigers SEN programme, to coach the children to play tag-rugby and learn and improve skills such as: teamwork, communication and leadership.

Swimming provision has increased confidence and attainment by a significant parentage. Year 6 have swimming booster session, allowing the children re-cap on water safety and to swim 25 meters. The government require that the children can swim 25m when they leave primary school. 2017-18 37% of year 6 children left school being able to swim 25m.

The sports premium also has allowed to children to participate in different activities outside of school, such as the Leicester Outdoor Pursuits centre allowing the children to be challenged and experience new activities.
