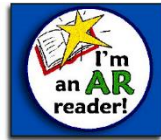


Homework Grid – Lent 1: Poetry: Tell me a Story by Benjamin Zephaniah

Speaking, Listening & Writing

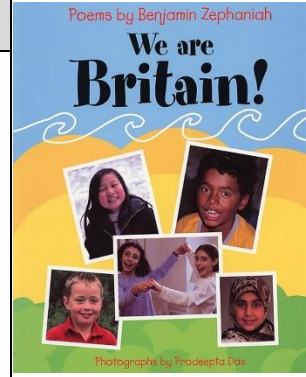
- Research and write a biography about Benjamin Zephaniah's life.
