Write a description about a midnight sky/starry scene or your favourite planet. 	 Problems, Science & Maths Draw a bar chart showing the distance of each planet in our solar system to the sun. Practise dividing and multiplying decimals by 10, 100 and 100. Eg 29.04 divided by 100= Practise using the formal method of multiplication: 4 digits by 2. eg 4906x27= 	 <u>Wider Curriculum</u> Explore the solar system and make a fact file about each planet. Draw a 'space' picture. Think about how you can use shading to add depth and detail to the image. Write an explanation text about how day and night are due to the Earth's rotation. Research how art has changed throughout history.
