





<p><b><u>Reading</u></b></p> <p>Ensure that you read your AR book daily for at least 20 minutes! Particularly focus on the 6, 7, 8, 9 and 12 times tables so that you know them without having to think about it! Playing on Times Table Rockstars at home is a fun way to do this! If you have lost your log in/password ask me for it!</p> 	<p><b><u>Spelling</u></b></p> <p>Continue to practise the statutory spelling list for year 5. Throughout the year we want you to learn these words so that you can use them confidently and independently in all areas of your writing. If you would like a new one, please ask. Go on Spelling Mash each week to do your spellings.</p>

<p><b><u>Speaking, Listening &amp; Writing</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write your own story based on a Greek Myth.</li> <li>• Read your story out loud using intonation for dramatic effect to someone else.</li> <li>• Write a description based on a place in one of the Greek Myths we have read about.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Problems, Science &amp; Maths</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When you next go to the supermarket, look at the deals you can find. Which deal is the best value?</li> <li>• Imagine you have a food budget of £50, what could you buy for a family of four for a week?</li> <li>• Practise using the formal method division: 4 digits by 2 e.g. 4906 divide by 12=</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Wider Curriculum</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write a persuasive advert about an item of food of your choice.</li> <li>• Research Ancient Greece and make a fact file.</li> <li>• Create a picture or collage of a picture inspired by Ancient Greece.</li> </ul>
