How to give consent for your child to get the flu vaccination

- Make a note of the code for your school. For **Sacred Heart Catholic Voluntary Academy Leicester** the school code is **LE138081** and visit www.leicsandrutlandimms.co.uk or scan the QR code using your smartphone camera to go straight to the website.
- Select **Seasonal Flu**, enter the school code and fill out the form. On the consent declaration page, you can consent for the nasal flu vaccine **or** the injectable flu vaccine.
- You will receive a confirmation email when the form is submitted.
