

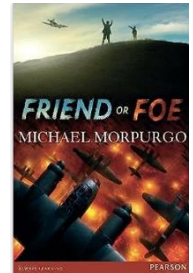
## Homework Grid – Advent Term 1
