We have ongoing litter-picking opportunities – if your child would like to join the Litter Picking Team, please sign up on the sheet outside Silver Birch Class. The **Eco Club** runs on **Tuesdays from 12:30 PM** to **12:50 PM**, and we also have **Energy Rangers** who help by ensuring classroom lights are off to save energy. If your child would like to be an **Energy Ranger**, please sign up on the sheet outside Silver Birch Class.

#### **Energy Rangers**

Our school's **Eco Champions** and **Energy Rangers** are keeping an eye on saving energy and reducing CO2 by ensuring all electrical equipment—interactive boards, laptops and lights—is turned off when not in use, especially when a room is empty. The team will conduct a daily **Energy Check**, scoring each class on their energy efficiency, with a maximum of 4 points awarded if all equipment is switched off.

### Energy Efficiency Scoring:

- **1 point** if all lights are off when the room is empty, or partially off if someone is working.
- **1 point** if the interactive board is off.
- **1 point** if the laptop is off.
- **0 points** if lights are left on when the room is empty.

Each day, Year Group Eco Champions and Energy Rangers will check their year group classrooms to monitor energy use. Let's work together to **SAVE OUR WORLD!** ③

## Wraparound Care Survey:

Thank you very much to the parents who replied to the Wraparound Care survey that was sent out in September. The response for a paid after school service was very low and therefore not feasible to run here are Sacred Heart. However, we have been in touch with a nearby nursery, Kiddisafe (Coleman Nursery), who do run an afterschool provision. They also have a nursery vehicle so they can pick up from Sacred Heart and bring the children to their setting; which is fantastic.

Currently they have a transport fee of £6.50 followed by an hourly session rate of approx £5.00. They are open until 6pm and children can be collected from Sacred Heart just after the school day finishes at 3:15pm.

If you have an expression of interest in using Kiddie Safe's facility, please contact our school office so we can liaise directly with Kiddisafe and give them an approximation of those who may want to avail of their provision.
