




#### Our Mission

### Early Years

Our Early Years Foundation Stage:

Foundation 1 (Nursery) and Foundation 2 (Reception) gives children a happy, confident start to school life. They develop early skills in communication, reading, writing and number while growing in independence and curiosity. Our indoor and outdoor spaces encourage active, joyful learning. 
